Location – IL Route 3

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that IL Rte. 3 will have one lane closures just south of Brooklyn beginning on Thursday, September 29, 2011 and completed by Wednesday evening, October 6, 2011, weather permitting. These lane restrictions will begin after 9:00 a.m. and be removed by 3:00 p.m. daily. These lane restrictions are required to install new structural steel girders. In addition, a total closure of IL Rte. 3 will also occur and be limited to a maximum of 15 minutes for the hours shown above. After each 15 minute closure, the lane will re-open and traffic will be allowed to clear. Traffic will be guided through the work zone by use of construction signing and flaggers.

Please use extreme caution when driving through the work zone. The contractor on this project is Keeley & Sons, Inc. of East St. Louis, IL.
