## **Mississippi River Bridge construction cameras now live**

ST. LOUIS – The Missouri and Illinois Departments of Transportation are pleased to announce that two construction cameras for the Mississippi River Bridge project are now live to provide images of work on the river bridge.

Two cameras, one facing the river and one facing what will become the Missouri approach, are providing images shot about every 10 minutes on the project.

“Work in the river has started, although it is delayed due to the height of the river water,” said Andrew Gates, Mississippi River Bridge community relations coordinator. “We are expecting our contractor to begin work soon on the Missouri approach, as well.”

At least two more cameras are expected to be added to the list of construction cameras, when those projects get underway.
